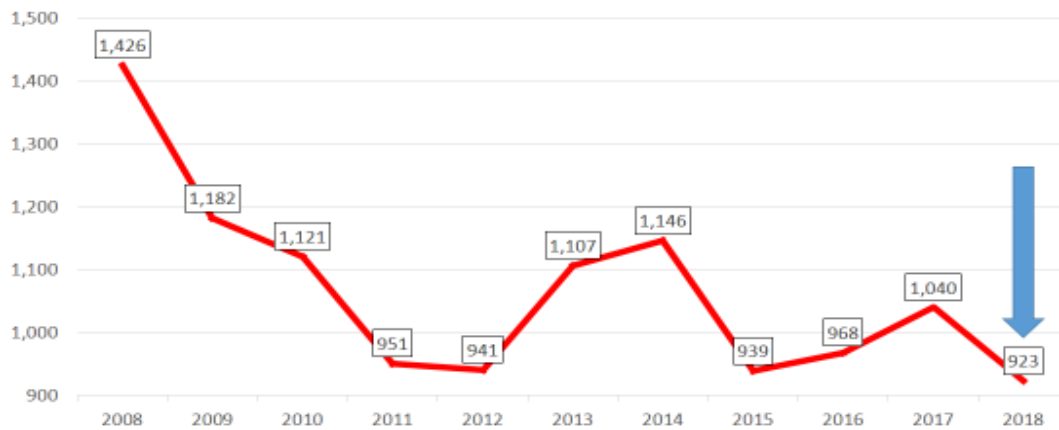


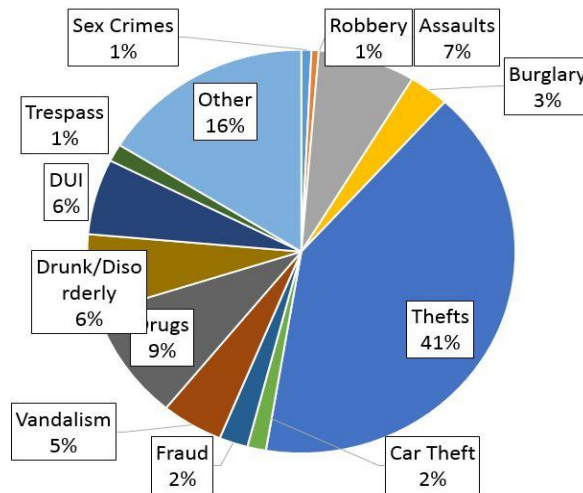
2018 was the lowest crime year ever for the City of Englewood. Reported crimes in 2018 were down 11% from 2017. More importantly, reported crimes in 2018 were down 15% from the average of the past 10 years.

The most significant reduction came in the category of thefts. The largest percentage of reported crimes in Englewood is theft at 41% with shoplifting still being the single most significant crime at 26% of all reported crimes.

Other areas of interest in reviewing crime statistics:

- Violent Crimes (Murder, Rape, Robbery, Aggravated assault) only account for approximately 1% of overall crime. Aggravated assaults and robberies have dropped significantly. Since 1999 we averaged about 9 robberies a year and we had 5 in 2018. For the same time period, we averaged about 10 aggravated assaults and we had only 2 in 2018.
- Property crimes (burglary/B&E, theft, auto theft, arson) accounts for about 46% of reported crimes. Since 1999 we averaged about 41 burglaries/B&E's per year and in 2018 we had 28. Thefts since 1999 average around 404 per year and in 2018 we had 378.
- Sex crimes have significantly declined since 2015 when we shut down the two seedy hotels. We have not had any reported prostitution cases since 2015.
- Drug related offenses also have declined since its peak in 2014 when we had 121. Since then there has been a steady decline. In 2018 we had 85 drug related offenses. Over the last 10 years we average around 83 drug related offenses.
- Englewood Regional Dispatch Center had another busy year in 2018 with nearly 40,000 calls for service. A call for service is any time a dispatcher is involved with an officer or fire personnel. This does not include phone calls which totaled 52,355. Dispatch is also responsible for monitoring the 65 security cameras located throughout Englewood.
