AN ORDINANCE: AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PARTICIPATE IN BRIDGE INSPECTION PROGRAM SERVICES (PID #109334) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Englewood has determined the need for the described project: *Bridge Inspection Program Services, including, but not limited to routine inspections, element level inspections, critical-findings reports, fracture critical member inspections, load rating calculations and reports, weight limits posting sign recommendations, scour assessments, scour plan of actions, development of fracture critical plans, and underwater dive inspection reports if needed;* and

WHEREAS, the ODOT funding portion is 100% and the local share is 0%

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I Being in the public interest, the City of Englewood gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION II The City of Englewood shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project. The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the cost for the Bridge Inspection Program Services requested by the City and agreed to by the State.


SECTION III That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into the attached contract, be and made part hereof, with the Director of Transportation which is necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION V It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements.

SECTION VI






