A RESOLUTION: DECLARING THE OFFICIAL INTENT AND REASONABLE EXPECTATION OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, OHIO ON BEHALF OF THE STATE OF OHIO (THE BORROWER) TO REIMBURSE ITS RESERVE FOR WATER IMPROVEMENTS FUND FOR THE LODESTONE DRIVE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT (CD49W/CD50W), AND THE WINNIMAC AVENUE WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT (CD47W/CD48W), AND TO REIMBURSE ITS RESERVE FOR SEWER IMPROVEMENTS FUND FOR THE AEROBIC DIGESTER AERATION SYSTEM REPLACEMENT PROJECT (CD35W/CD36W), AND THE I-70 PUMP STATION PROJECT (CD45W/CD46W) WITH THE PROCEEDS OF TAX-EXEMPT DEBT OF THE STATE OF OHIO.

WHEREAS, a declaration of official intent is required by a local subdivision seeking reimbursement from the Ohio Public Works Commission for project costs incurred and paid by the subdivision.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, OHIO, ON BEHALF OF THE STATE OF OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I That the City of Englewood reasonably expects to receive a reimbursement for the Lodestone Drive and Winnimac Avenue Water Main Replacement Projects along with the Aerobic Digester Aeration System Replacement Project and I-70 Pump Station Replacement Project as set forth in Appendix A of the Project Agreements with the proceeds of bonds to be issued by the State of Ohio.

SECTION II That the maximum aggregate principal amount of bonds, other than for costs of issuance, expected to be issued by the State of Ohio for reimbursement to the local subdivision is one hundred ninety-four thousand, four hundred forty three dollars (\$194,443) for the Lodestone Drive Water Main Replacement Project; one hundred eighty-seven thousand, seven hundred seventy dollars (\$187,770) for the Winnimac Avenue Water Main Replacement Project; two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for the Aerobic Digester Aeration System Replacement Project; and four hundred fifty-six thousand, eight hundred eighty dollars (\$456,880) for the I-70 Pump Station Replacement Project.

SECTION III

That the Clerk of Council of the City of Englewood is hereby directed to file a copy of this Resolution with this city for the inspection and examination of all persons interested therein and to deliver a copy of this Resolution to the Ohio Public Works Commission.


SECTION IV


