A RESOLUTION: AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXTEND A 2006 CONTRACT FOR WEEKLY REFUSE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICES, AND TO EXTEND AN AGREEMENT FOR WASTE REMOVAL AND LANDFILL SERVICE FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, WITH RUMPKE OF OHIO, INC AND APPROVING THE CHARGES ASSESSED AND COLLECTED FOR RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE COLLECTON AND DISPOSAL EACH YEAR UNTIL MARCH 31, 2027.

WHEREAS, a request for bids to provide weekly refuse collection and disposal services was advertised in the Dayton Daily News on Monday, September 25, 2006; and

WHEREAS, three (3) sealed bids were received and opened publicly on Wednesday, October, 25, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Rumpke of Ohio, Inc. (Rumpke) was subsequently awarded a one-year contract, commencing April 1, 2007, with four annual options for renewal through March 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, Rumpke has previously agreed to hold the contract price for six (6) additional 12-month terms commencing April 1, 2012 and ending March 31, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City has previously negotiated a 36-month contract extension to include a 4% rate increase per unit, per month effective April 1, 2018; an additional 5% rate increase per unit, per month effective April 1, 2019; and an additional 5% rate increase per unit, per month effective April 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City has negotiated a 72-month contract extension to include a 4% rate increase per unit, per month effective April 1, 2021;
and an additional 4% rate increase per unit, per month effective April 1, 2022;
and an additional 4% rate increase per unit, per month effective April 1, 2023;
and an additional 4% rate increase per unit, per month effective April 1, 2024;
and an additional 4% rate increase per unit, per month effective April 1, 2025;
and an additional 4% rate increase per unit, per month effective April 1, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Rumpke further agreed to extend a proposal dated July 2, 2015 for waste removal and landfill service for the wastewater treatment plant, and the City has negotiated a 72-month contract extension to include an annual price increase not to exceed 3% each year through March 31, 2027;

WHEREAS, This new contract will provide additional costs to the City and refuse rates need to be updated for our residents; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, MONTGOMERY COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to extend a contract for weekly refuse and disposal services with **Rumpke of Ohio, Inc., 10795 Hughes Road, Cincinnati, OH 45251**, pursuant to the negotiated terms and specifications, for an additional 72-month period beginning April 1, 2021 and ending March 31, 2027.

SECTION II That the City Manager is further authorized and directed to continue an agreement for waste removal and landfill service for the wastewater treatment plant with **Rumpke of Ohio, Inc., 10795 Hughes Road, Cincinnati, OH 45251**, pursuant to the negotiated terms and specifications, for an additional 72-month period beginning April 1, 2021 and ending March 31, 2027.

SECTION III For refuse service provided from April 1, 2021 to March 30, 2022, the monthly charges for residential refuse collection services as provided for in Chapter 1064, Residential Solid Waste Collection and Disposal, of the Codified Ordinances of Englewood, Ohio, are as follows:

Single family residence including curbside recycling	\$14.62
Surcharge for Carryout Service	\$12.00
Surcharge for Toter Service	\$ 3.00
Multi-family residential dumpster service, with recycling	\$44.00

SECTION IV For refuse service provided from April 1, 2022 to March 30, 2023, the monthly charges for residential refuse collection services as provided for in Chapter 1064, Residential Solid Waste Collection and Disposal, of the Codified Ordinances of Englewood, Ohio, are as follows:

Single family residence including curbside recycling	\$15.20
Surcharge for Carryout Service	\$12.00
Surcharge for Toter Service	\$ 3.00
Multi-family residential dumpster service, with recycling	\$44.00

SECTION V

For refuse service provided from April 1, 2023 to March 30, 2024, the monthly charges for residential refuse collection services as provided for in Chapter 1064, Residential Solid Waste Collection and Disposal, of the Codified Ordinances of Englewood, Ohio, are as follows:

Single family residence including curbside recycling	\$15.81
Surcharge for Carryout Service	\$12.00
Surcharge for Toter Service	\$ 3.00
Multi-family residential dumpster service, with recycling	\$44.00

SECTION VI

For refuse service provided from April 1, 2024 to March 30, 2025, the monthly charges for residential refuse collection services as provided for in Chapter 1064, Residential Solid Waste Collection and Disposal, of the Codified Ordinances of Englewood, Ohio, are as follows:

Single family residence including curbside recycling	\$16.44
Surcharge for Carryout Service	\$12.00
Surcharge for Toter Service	\$ 3.00
Multi-family residential dumpster service, with recycling	\$44.00

SECTION VII

For refuse service provided from April 1, 2025 to March 30, 2026, the monthly charges for residential refuse collection services as provided for in Chapter 1064, Residential Solid Waste Collection and Disposal, of the Codified Ordinances of Englewood, Ohio, are as follows:

Single family residence including curbside recycling	\$17.10
Surcharge for Carryout Service	\$12.00
Surcharge for Toter Service	\$ 3.00
Multi-family residential dumpster service, with recycling	\$44.00

SECTION VIII

For refuse service provided from April 1, 2026 to March 30, 2027, the monthly charges for residential refuse collection services as provided for in Chapter 1064, Residential Solid Waste Collection and Disposal, of the Codified Ordinances of Englewood, Ohio, are as follows:

Single family residence including curbside recycling	\$17.79
Surcharge for Carryout Service	\$12.00
Surcharge for Toter Service	\$ 3.00
Multi-family residential dumpster service, with recycling	\$44.00

SECTION IX

and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.


SECTION X That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect at the earliest date allowed by law.




