AN ORDINANCE: AMENDING SECTION 672.01 OF THE ENGLEWOOD CODIFIED ORDINANCES CONCERNING THE DISCHARGING OF FIREARMS TO ADD "OTHER WEAPONS"

WHEREAS, Section 672.01 of the Englewood Codified Ordinances establishes and delineates certain prohibitions, penalties, and other regulations involving weapons including firearms; and

WHEREAS, Section 672.01 Englewood City Council was codified by Ordinance #19-23 to only address firearms; and

WHEREAS, the Englewood Police Department requests additional language to include "OTHER WEAPONS" to provide additional enforcement options; and

WHEREAS, the City is authorized as a charter municipality to exercise all powers of local self-government.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENGLEWOOD, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I Section 672.01 of the Englewood Codified Ordinances shall be amended (in red):

672.01 DISCHARGING FIREARMS AND OTHER WEAPONS

(a) Except as provided in Subsection (b) below, no person shall discharge any air gun, rifle, shotgun, revolver, pistol or other firearm, or make use of any sling or arrow, within the corporate limits of the City.

(b) This section does not apply when a firearm is discharged in self-defense, in defense of others, by a police officer in the discharge of official duty, or when the individual discharging the firearm has a permit issued pursuant to subsection (c) hereof.

(c) The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to issue a permit to discharge any air gun, rifle, shotgun, revolver, pistol or other firearm, or make use of any sling or arrow, within the corporate limits of the City to any person or organization where the Chief of

Police determines that such discharge will not be detrimental to the health, safety, and welfare of the City.

(d) The term "firearm" as used in this section shall have the same meaning as the definition of that term in Section 2923.11(B) of the Ohio Revised Code.

(e) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor of the fourth degree.


SECTION II


SECTION III




